The backbone of the Society's activities is the series of monthly talks. TWHAS meets (usually) on the second Wednesday of each month, except August and December, in St Mary's Church, Market Place, Wallingford, at 7.45pm for 8.00pm. Visitors are welcome at £4.00 per person.

Members receive *TWHAS Now*, the monthly (except for August) newsletter, delivered either by e-mail or in hard copy according to the member's preference. This contains information on all the current and future meetings and events organised by the Society, and on the activities of Wallingford Museum. (The Museum's day-to-day management is undertaken by the Museum Board of Directors in association with the TWHAS Committee). The TWHAS membership card allows unlimited free entry to Wallingford Museum.

Members are able to participate in local history research, exhibition planning and work at the Museum, and any practical archaeology – fieldwalking, geophysics and excavation. The current *Garden Archaeology Project* is opening many very exciting opportunities. A number of TWHAS members also choose to assist as Custodians at the museum.

The TWHAS Documents Group has been working for some years to transcribe and summarise key sources of information about Wallingford's long and rich history, known as *Sources for Wallingford's History*, and a Research Group is using this wonderful resource. The Museum/TWHAS library is also available to members by arrangement
